Pay for Performance: CPT Category II Codes for Blood Pressure

Below are the codes that can be billed on a claim to document a patient's Blood Pressure:

3074F	Systolic BP less than 130mmHg
3075F	Systolic BP 130-139mmHg
3077F	Systolic BP greater than or equal to 140 mmHg
3078F	Diastolic BP less than 80 mmHg
3079F	Diastolic BP 80-89 mmHg
3080F	Diastolic BP greater than or equal to 90mmHg
